# 2009 13 Year Old World Series Information Sheet

## **Hotels**

All players from the World Series Teams will stay at the **Shilo Inn Hotel** located at 3101 Temple Avenue, Pomona CA 91768. All qualifying teams must call Wendy at (909-263-5284) immediately upon qualifying to book their rooms. No team will be allowed to book rooms directly without approval from Wendy. We have blocked 150 rooms for this time frame. A Rooming List will be sent to each qualifying team. Upon the team's completion of the rooming list, the form must be emailed back to Wendy at steadybreeze@aol.com. She will then coordinate with the hotel the teams needs. This process has been carefully worked out between the hotel and our league to ensure a positive experience for all parties.

Each World Series team that qualifies for travel has 5 rooms paid for by our league. All other parents from the World Series teams have a choice of rooms, but must stay at the Shilo Inn.

## **Room Selection**

The standard room sleeps four with two queen size beds or a king size bed with a pull out sofa for \$129. They also have a suite available, complete with kitchen including a full size refrigerator, microwave, and stove for \$169. Both rooms come with a complete hot breakfast for four daily between 6:00am and 10:00am. This breakfast is served in the dining room. This will be our host hotel for the tournament.

## **Amenities**

There will be a greeting area set up by our committee for the teams to visit when they check in at the hotel. Check in is 4pm and check out is noon. Hospitality will hold luggage if requested. The Hotel has a pool, fitness center, Jacuzzi, restaurant, and lounge. We are very excited about our partnership with this hotel and need 100% participation from all World Series teams staying here. **There will be no exceptions!**

There will be shuttle vans available to take players and coaches to and from all games and practices at Community Park. The shuttle schedule will be located at the front desk. ## **Opening Ceremonies**

Opening Day ceremonies for the World Series Teams will be Friday July 31st at 10:30 am. We will lineup all teams and introduce them as well as league, and pony dignitaries. Please make sure that all players are present and in uniform for this event. Players do not need to wear their baseball pants, but should have their top and hat with them.

### **Managers Meetings- 13u World Series**

At 11:30pm on July 31st we will have the World Series managers meeting at Community Park. This will immediately follow the Opening Day Ceremonies. At this meeting the weekly passes for all parents, siblings and relatives will be collected by our board. Please be prepared with all of your pass information at this meeting. It is imperative that you work with your team and collect the weekly pass money ahead of time. Your parents and families will save money by buying the weekly pass.

### **Weekly Passes**

The weekly pass for the tournament will be \$25 for adults 13 and older, and \$12 for all children 3-12. Children under 3 are free. The manager must get with all of his parents and collect their weekly pass money. At the Managers meeting he must turn in all cash or checks to our treasurer. (One check from the manager is preferable.) On Thursday, Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday the gate charge will be \$8 for adults and \$5 for kids 3-12. Our security staff will be checking everyone in attendance at games. Anyone that does not have a pass will be required to purchase one, or will be removed from the park.
